

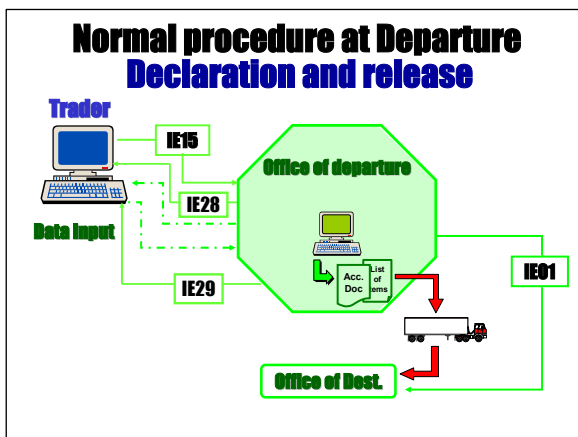
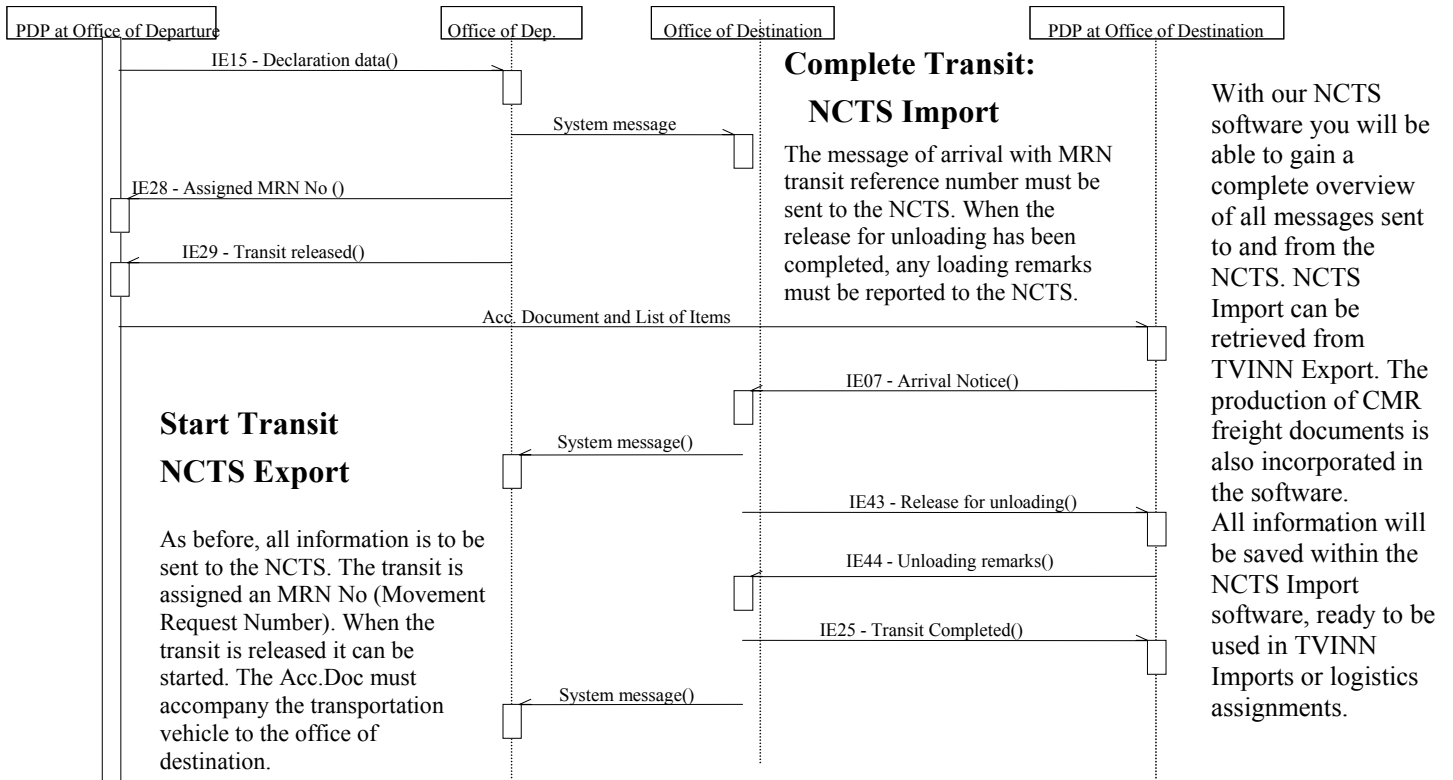
New Computerised Transit System

NCTS – Export and Import

The diagram below illustrates the direction of messages in NCTS Export (Start Transit) and NCTS Import (Complete Transit), taken from the Main Document of the DDNTA for Phase 3.1 from the Taxation and Customs Union DG.

The procedures and routines of the Transit Convention remain unchanged.

The set of forms (T1) has been replaced by the "Transit-Accompanying Document". When a transit has been completed a message of arrival as well as any loading remarks are to be sent electronically. The competent authority will then receive an electronic receipt of "Released" and "Completed" transits.

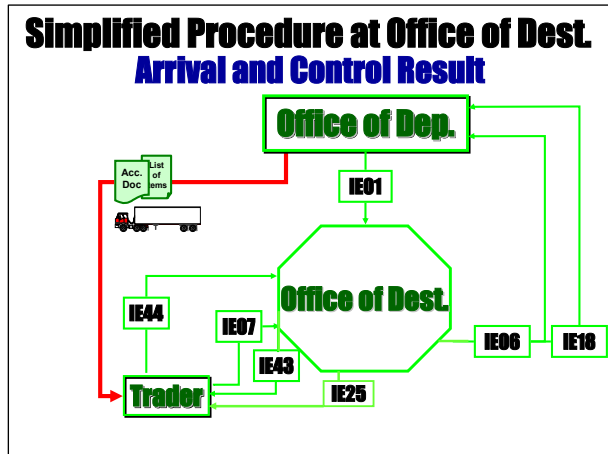


Simplified Procedure (Export) (the company must be an "authorised trader"). The principal duty payer sends an electronic transit to the NCTS. When the transit has been released, The NCTS automatically informs the principal duty payer, who will then print the document accompanying the transportation vehicle.

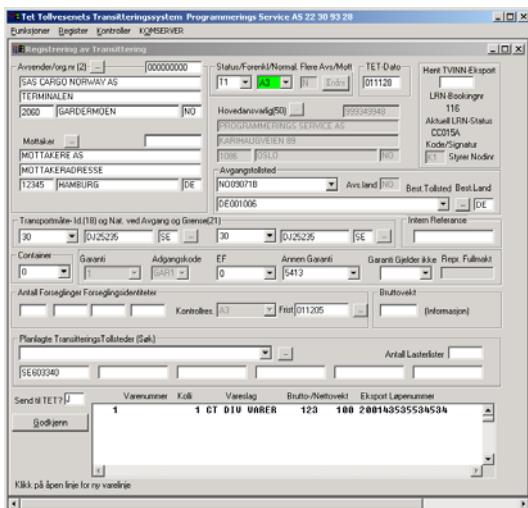
Simplified procedure (import):

(the company must be an "authorised recipient")

The transit document, which is started in another country, is to be completed electronically. When a transit accompanying document has been received, an electronic arrival notice must be sent to the NCTS. With the arrival notice as a basis, the NCTS will send the principal duty payer a release of unloading. The principal duty payer will then be able to load and ensure that the commodities correspond to the information given in the transit accompanying document. If the information given corresponds to the commodities, a loading notice without comments must be sent to the NCTS.



If the commodities do not correspond to the transit accompanying document a loading notice with deviations must be sent instead. When the transit has been completed, the principal duty payer will receive a notice of "transit completed" from the NCTS.



The transit (Export)

can be done with a TVINN Export declaration as a basis. It contains the following message types: Declaration data, assigned MRN number, release, control of transit, requested/recommended cancellation and a final cancellation decision. A transcript of the transit accompanying document, search/copy/control functions, etc.

The transit (Import)

can be used as a basis for a TVINN Import. Message types: Arrival notice, release for unloading, unloading remarks and transit completed.
